Bus parking at Seattle Center is limited.

There are three, on-street areas around our campus signed and designated as "Bus Only," two of these are reserved for School Buses during the school day (M-F, 9 am - 3 pm):


- East side, First Ave N, north of Thomas St.
- East side, Warren Ave N, north of Republican St.
- West side, 4th Ave N, b/w Republican and Mercer. (4th Ave is one-way northbound.)

Please use these areas when parking your bus.

Loading Zones. When picking up or dropping off students, please use one of the many Loading Zones around campus. Refer to the map at right to find the Loading Zone closest to your group's destination.

Please be aware that on-street parking in the Uptown neighborhood where Seattle Center is located is very limited. Most spaces are metered, and all vehicles, including buses, can be ticketed for violations.

There are many loading zones and drop off points around the campus (see map), but when parking for more than a few minutes, please direct your bus to one of the on-street parking locations listed above and shown on the map.



Load Loading Zones

- 2nd Ave N, south of Thomas St: Best for Center House, Children's Theater, Pacific Science Center.
- 1st Ave N, between Harrison and Republican: Best for KeyArena.
- Republican, at Warren Ave N: Best for Northwest Rooms, VERA Project.
- Mercer St, between Warren and 3rd N: Best for Seattle Repertory Theater, Intiman, McCaw Hall.

Park Bus Parking

- First Ave N, north of Thomas - approx. 6 buses.
- Warren Ave N, north of Republican - approx. 2 buses in "Charter Bus Zone."
- 4th Ave N, north of Republican - approx 7 buses. One-way north, enter from 5th/Republican.
