Position Title: Summer Season Lighting Assistant

Summer Season Description:

This summer, Seattle Children's Theatre Drama School will produce a Summer Season of six productions in the 485-seat Charlotte Martin Theatre at Seattle Center, including two one-act plays, one full-length play, two one-act musicals and one full-length musical. These productions feature student actors directed by teaching artists, and are designed, built, and run by professional SCT staff working alongside student interns and volunteer assistants.

Position Description:

We are seeking one volunteer lighting assistant for Summer 2019, to learn about designing, hanging, focusing, maintaining and running stage lighting. The lighting assistant will work on all four Summer Season shows, supervised and mentored by the Student Shows Lighting Designer and Technical Director. The Lighting Assistant will also have some run crew responsibilities.

Throughout the summer, assistants will meet regularly to share experiences and receive ongoing coaching and support from the staff. SCT will help arrange credit for community service hours on request.

Time Commitment: June 24 – August 11 full-time. Hours will vary week by week; there will be evening and weekend hours.

Qualifications: Minimum 2 years of high school required, and one year of experience with technical theatre, including some lighting and run crew experience.
