The SCT Education Outreach financial aid is available to schools or youth groups that could not otherwise afford the experience.

Limited need-based scholarships are available for:

- O Dramatic Connection Workshops | 60 minute workshops that extend and explore the themes, characters, historical context, and production elements of the mainstage show. Workshops can occur either before or after the play, and can be held at SCT or at your location.
- Specialty Workshops | Extended skill-based workshops designed to support your curriculum. For a complete list of workshop options please http://www.sct.org/For-Educators/Outreach/Drama-Workshops.
- Residencies | Six or more hours of extended skill-based classes designed to support your curriculum unit. For a complete list of residency option please visit http://www.sct.org/For-Educators/Outreach/Artist-Residencies

The cost for outreach workshops or residencies are \$100 per hour. Discounts are available for multiple hours at a single location. Financial aid may cover up to 50% of the total program cost. Financial aid is based on demonstrated program needs. For school groups it is based on the number of students enrolled in the free and reduced price lunch program.
