Position Title: Student Shows Sound Assistant

Student Shows Description:

Seattle Children's Theatre Drama School will produce five Student Shows in the 485-seat Charlotte Martin Theatre at Seattle Center, including one full-length and one one-act musical. These productions feature student actors directed by teaching artists, and are designed, built and run by professional SCT staff, student interns and assistants supervised by staff.

Position Description:

We are seeking one volunteer Sound assistant for Student Shows 2017, to learn about and assist with building sound cues, running sound and mixing boards, and placing and maintaining speakers, microphones and other sound equipment. This assistant will work on all four Student Shows, supervised and mentored by our Student Shows Sound Designer and Technical Coordinator. The Sound Assistant will also have run crew responsibilities.

Throughout the summer, interns and assistants will meet regularly to share experiences and receive ongoing coaching and support from the staff. SCT will help arrange credit for community service hours on request.

Time commitment: June 26- August 13 full-time. Hours will vary week by week; there will be evening and weekend hours.

Qualifications: Minimum 2 years of high school required, and one year of experience with technical theatre, including some sound construction and run crew experience.
